Modular training concept - Learning targets

Module 1

Overview of product line

Participants learn the details, differences, influences and service information of BGs and the undercarriage, KDK system, Kelly bar and components.

Module 2

Through imparting important safety information on stability, the participant receives an understanding of the technology of ropes and safety on job sites.

Module 3

Participants learn the basics of the technology of the different types of equipment. Safe rigging and de-rigging, procedures and operation at the construction site and loading and unloading of equipment. Participants learn how an operator can obtain such information in the future.

Module 4

In this module participants will learn about electrical control and safety components. In addition they will learn how to behave in a safe manner when other work is being carried out, such as when equipment is being jump started or welding is being done. Basic explanation of the hydraulic system, including important safety instructions.

Module 5

Participants will learn about the set-up and handling of the instruction manual.

Module 6

Overview of drilling, drilling equipment and their respective uses for different kinds of soil.
